DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:

Repair 200 linear feet of a severely eroded and entrenched section of Bloody Nose Trail in Montana de Oro SP, to reduce erosion and create a more sustainable trail for visitors. Work will:

- Cut dead plant material with chainsaws to fill the entrenched trail,
- Level berms to generate soil and fill the entrenched trail using a mini excavator,
- California Conservation Corps staff will move soil to the project site using motorized wheel barrows,
- Repair existing peeler core steps and add up to 4 new peeler cores steps secured with 3-foot lengths of 5/8 inch rebar.
- Level and finish the trail surface using McLeod tools and plate compactors.
