NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A NEGATIVE DECLARATION FOR THE DUNNIGAN WATER DISTRICT WATER TRANSFER PROJECT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Dunnigan Water District (District) plans to adopt negative declaration for the proposed water transfer. The public hearing is expected to be held by the Board of Directors on June 16, 2021 at 9:30am, at the District Office, 3817 1st Street, Dunnigan, CA 95937.

The Project proposes to transfer as much as 2,665 acre-feet of water annually until 2025. Water would be transferred from 9 entities. The Project is located in Yolo, Sutter, and Colusa Counties.

Pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), an Initial Study/Negative Declaration has been prepared, describing the degree of potential environmental impacts of the proposed project. The District has assessed the potential environmental impacts of this proposed project and has determined that they will be less than significant. Copies of the Initial Study and proposed Negative Declaration are on file and available for public review at the District Office, 3817 1st Street, Dunnigan, CA 95937. The public review period during which the City will receive comments on the proposed Negative Declaration will begin on May 12, 2021 and end on June 11, 2021.
