The Project includes the updating of the Housing Element to address housing needs for the October 2021 to October 2029 Planning Period. The SCAG RHNA allocation for the City identified a housing need of 517 housing units. The RHNA allocation for Signal Hill includes 161 very low-income units, 78 low-income units, 90 moderate-income units, and 188 above moderate-income units. The Project area encompasses the entirety of the City limits, approximately 2.2 square miles. Housing Inventory Sites will be identified within the Housing Element for the development of up to 724 housing units, in line with the recommendation of the California Department of Housing and Community Development (HCD) to allot for 15 to 30 percent above a local government's allocated housing units. The Project also identifies four Housing Inventory Sites as required by Government Code section 65583.2(a).
