Project Title: Routine Maintenance of Stream Channels and Drainage Facilities (Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-23320-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located within the Town of Loomis boundaries. The watercourses included within this Agreement include the following streams and their tributaries: Secret Ravine, Sucker Ravine, and Antelope Creek.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-23320-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Town of Loomis.

The project includes routine maintenance activities and culvert replacement in several streams and tributaries within the Town of Loomis. Routine maintenance activities will include the removal of debris and obstructions, sediment removal, vegetation control in channels, tree trimming, repair of existing erosion control works, temporary water diversions, trail maintenance, beaver dam removal, channel alignment maintenance, geotechnical sampling, and bridge washing, graffiti removal, and painting.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
