Project Title: Outfall Improvements Project, Phase 7—Valves Replacement (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. CCA-14310-R3)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at Walnut Creek, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 38.01358, Longitude -122.06837; 5019 Imhoff Place, Martinez, CA, 94553.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number CCA-14310-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Central Contra Costa Sanitary District.

The project will divert secondary-treated wastewater effluent into Walnut Creek via an existing wet-weather bypass structure while Central Contra Costa Sanitary District replaces two in-line 60-inch valves at the Martinez treatment plant.
