PROJECT DESCRIPTION

CAL FIRE will be leasing a new facility to meet the needs of the Emergency Response and Preparedness program and support the staffing of two Initial Attack California Conservation Camp fire crews.

The facility will consist of eight (8) sleeping quarters, bathrooms and showers, a kitchen, a dining area, a laundry facility, and a small garage for equipment/vehicle storage consisting of approximately 3,625 sf..

Minor interior improvements may be necessary.

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REASONS PROJECT IS EXEMPT

This project fits under 15301 Existing Facilities, Class 1: Consists of the operation, repair, maintenance, permitting, *leasing*, licensing, or minor alteration of existing public or private structures, facilities, mechanical equipment, or topographical features, involving negligible or no expansion of existing or former use. CAL FIRE staff confirmed that no exceptions apply which would preclude the use of a Notice of Exemption for this project. CAL FIRE staff has concluded that no significant environmental impact would occur to aesthetics, agriculture and forestland/timberland, air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, energy, geology and soils, greenhouse gas emissions, hazards and hazardous materials, hydrology and water quality, land use planning, mineral resources, noise, population and housing, public services, recreation, transportation/traffic, utilities and service systems, or wildfire.
