**Project Title:** Placer 49 Safety Improvement Project (03-4H600) (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-27101-R2) Amendment #1

**Project Location:** The seven project locations are located along State Route (SR) 49 in Placer County on tributaries to Orr Creek. Locations 1, 2, and 3 are adjacent to the intersection of Lorenson/Florence Road and SR 49. Location 7, 8, 9, and 10 are located adjacent to the intersection of Lone Star Road and SR 49. The project locations extend between post miles 8.7 and 10.6 on SR 49; located approximately 6.5 miles north of the town of Auburn, CA.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has issued Amendment #1 to the Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-27101-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, California Department of Transportation.

Amendment #1 increases the permanent habitat impact acreage, renumber the project locations, and adds an additional reporting measure for mitigation.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
