

**RESOLUTION NO. 8-2021**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE TEMPLETON  
COMMUNITY SERVICES DISTRICT FINDING THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT  
PLANT ACCESS ROAD REHABILITATION PROJECT EXEMPT FROM THE  
CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT AND APPROVING THE  
PROJECT.**

WHEREAS, The Templeton Community Services District ("District") Wastewater Treatment Plant Access Road Rehabilitation Project (Project) will consist of regrading and recompacting the existing base road, the addition of approximately 2 inches of class 2 aggregate base, and placement of a double chip seal pavement surface;

WHEREAS, the Project is a project under the California Environmental Quality Act (Section 21000 et seq. of the Public Resources Code, hereinafter referred to as CEQA), which requires that Local Agencies consider the environmental consequences of their actions before approving a project; and

WHEREAS, Section 15301(c) (Existing Facilities) of the State CEQA Guidelines (Chapter 3 of Division 6 of Title 14 of the California Code of Regulations) provides an exemption from CEQA for projects involving minor alterations to existing highways and streets, sidewalks, gutters, bicycle and pedestrian trails, and similar facilities (this includes road grading for the purpose of public safety); and

WHEREAS, the Project is included in the current 2020/21 Fiscal Year budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Directors of the Templeton Community Services District as follows:

1. Finds the Project exempt from CEQA pursuant to section 15301(c) of the State CEQA Guidelines and approves the Project.


