The project consists of both land use changes and physical improvements that would result in the establishment of 317 single-family dwellings across three (3) neighborhood concepts, communal open space, a new public park, and public improvements to the adjacent right-of-way.

Land use changes proposed by the project would remove the project area from the East Valley Corridor Specific Plan (EVCSP). The General Plan identifies the project site as Low Density Residential, which accommodates residential uses at a density of up to 6 dwelling units per acre.

Presently, the project site is zoned Science Research Park in the EVCSP, which is inconsistent with the General Plan. The project proposes removing the site from the EVCSP and establishing a new specific plan consistent with the existing general plan land use of Low Density Residential.
