Valley Sanitary District has developed a district-wide list of pipeline replacement projects. The purpose of these projects is to repair, rehabilitate, replace and/or realign aging or defective pipelines and/or segments projected to reach capacity within the foreseeable future. To date, VSD has identified a total of 371 segments or point locations throughout the District's service area that comprise the current list of repair/replacement projects. Additional segments may be identified and added as the projects are constructed. Pipeline segments would be repaired, rehabilitated (i.e., relined) or replaced/realigned within existing pipeline corridors.


