The Project landscaping, paving, retention basin construction and perimeter fencing installation.

The Project will result in incidental take of 71 western Joshua tree (*Yucca brevifolia*), which is protected under the WJTCA and the California Endangered Species Act. The WJTCA ITP referenced above as issued by CDFW authorizes incidental take of western Joshua tree that may occur as a result of Project implementation.
