The land uses proposed include: Low, Medium, and High Density Residential, Mixed-Use, and Parks/Recreation, including infrastructure and utilities to service the project The RWSP estimates between 2,432 – 2,682 residential units, and 375,000 and 875,000 square feet of Mixed-Use for commercial, office, service, or retail use, as well as some transitional care facilities. A large portion of the RWSP is intended to be an age-restricted active adult community, while a portion will not be age restricted. (See Project Description for more detail)
