Project Location - Specific: The project site is located on the south side of E. Cherokee Rd., 830 feet east of N. Overhiser Rd., Stockton. (APN/Address: 087-054-09 / 5550 E. Cherokee Rd., Stockton) (Supervisorial District: 4)

Project Location - City: located on the south side of E. Cherokee Rd., 830 feet east of N. Overhiser Rd., Stockton

Project Location - County: San Joaquin County

Project Description: Site Approval application to establish an unmanned, 10 megawatt (MW) battery energy storage system facility utilizing 0.4 acres of a 15-acre parcel to include 14 storage containers to house battery storage racks for lithium batteries with integrated fire suppression systems. The project will connect to PG&E's transmission grid at the existing Ceres substation located to the north of the site via a new 12.47 kV generating interconnection transmission line (gen-tie) and will receive, store, and discharge electricity to and from the grid. There is an existing trailer and equipment storage yard that will remain on-site. The project will not utilize water services. Storm drainage will be retained on-site. The property is not under a Williamson Act contract.

The Property is zoned AG-20 (General Agriculture, 20-acre minimum) and the General Plan designation is R/L (Low Density Residential).
