Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

18,500 linear feet (3.5 miles) of road blading to repair the roadway and to construct five (5) fire turnouts. Grading repair includes 2,065 cubic yards of cut and fill. Tree removal or trimming may be performed only as necessary for adequate vertical clearance. Renew existing Metro PCS facility, legalize AT&T facility.

Identify the project's significant or potentially significant effects and briefly describe any proposed mitigation measures that would reduce or avoid that effect.

Measures are included to mitigate the potential for erosion and sediment and dust control; restricting the timing of grading to occur outside of the wet season; protections for cultural, paleontological, or archaeological resources, including Native American resources; construction timing to minimize noise; and tree replanting and tree protection and to protect special status species, California red-legged frog, San Francisco garter snake, Mission Blue butterfly, San Bruno Elfin butterfly.
