**Project Title:** Permit No. 19624, Yolo Bypass West Levee Culvert Replacement

**Project Location/City/County:** The proposed project is located 0.3 miles north of Interstate 5 and 4.3 miles east of State Route 113, on Unit 3, Yolo Bypass West levee at Levee Mile 1.46 in Yolo County.

**Project Description:** Approval of Permit No. 19624, under California Code of Regulations, Title 23, Article 3, Section 6, for work within an adopted plan of flood control: To remove the three existing 48-inch diameter culverts and replace them with a single cast-in-place concrete box culvert of approximately 115 feet long, 3 feet wide, and 8 feet tall with four 6-foot by 6-foot bays. The project will also include the construction of cast-in-place concrete headwalls located at the inlet and outlet structures equipped with waterside flap gates and a positive closure device at the waterside levee crown.

This is to advise that the Central Valley Flood Protection Board, as the **Responsible Agency**, approved the above described project on June 24, 2022 and made the following determinations regarding the above described project:
