The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), in cooperation with the Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Agency (Metro), the Gateway Cities Council of Governments (GCCOG), the Southern California Association of Governments, the Ports of Los Angeles and Long Beach, and the Interstate 5 (I-5) Joint Powers Authority have completed the Final Environmental Impact Report/Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIR/FEIS) for the I-710 Corridor Project. A Recirculated Draft Environmental Impact Report/Supplemental Draft Environmental Impact Statement (RDEIR/SDEIS) for the I-710 Corridor Project was circulated in 2017. Based on comments received on the RDEIR/SDEIS and coordination with external partners, Alterative 1 (No Build) has been identified as the Preferred Alternative. The project had evaluated two build alternatives and one no build alternative. The build alternative proposed adding lane(s) to the freeway mainline under one build alternative and construction of a separate four-lane freight movement corridor under the other build alternative.

Caltrans is the lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and as assigned by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) under the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA). Caltrans has studied the effects that the proposed project may have on the environment and community. The results of these studies are contained in the FEIR/FEIS. The purpose of this notice is to inform the public of its completion and availability to any interested individuals.
