

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY OF A DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT and NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Chaffey Community College District (District), as Lead Agency under the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (DEIR) for the Rancho Cucamonga Campus Master Plan (State Clearinghouse No. 2021060412) to address the potential impacts associated with implementation of the proposed project. The purpose of this notice is to (1) serve as a Notice of Availability (NOA) of a DEIR pursuant to the CEQA Guidelines Section 15087 and (2) advise and solicit comments regarding the content of the DEIR.

NOTICE OF AVAILABILITY: Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21083 and CEQA Guidelines Section 15087, the DEIR will be available for a 45-day public review from **Friday, April 15, 2022**, through **Monday, May 30, 2022**. Pursuant to Public Resources Code Section 21080.4, responsible and trustee agencies must submit any comments in response to this notice no later than 45 days after receipt.

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Please also be informed that the Chaffey College Governing Board will hold a public meeting on **August 25, 2022**, or soon thereafter, to receive public comments, and consider the EIR and the proposed actions.

PROJECT LOCATION: The 200-acre Chaffey College Rancho Cucamonga campus is at 5885 Haven Avenue in the northern part of the City of Rancho Cucamonga, San Bernardino County (Assessor's Parcel Number 020119115).

PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The project consists of demolition, construction, and renovation of buildings and campus facilities on the 200-acre campus in five phases over 30 years. The proposed project would involve demolition of approximately 229,000 square feet of existing buildings and facilities, construction of approximately 397,000 square feet of new buildings, and renovation and repurposing of approximately 148,000 square feet of existing buildings. The proposed project would also provide various outdoor space improvements, athletic fields improvement, and ADA and site improvements. Table 1 describes different project components proposed for each of the five phases.

ENVIRONMENTAL ISSUES: Based on the analysis in the DEIR, the District determined that implementation of the proposed project would result in potentially significant impacts related to air quality, biological resources, cultural resources, noise, and tribal cultural resources; however, with implementation of mitigation measures, all impacts except cultural resources were reduced to a less than significant level. The District determined that implementation of the proposed project would result in significant and unavoidable impacts related to historical cultural resources.
