Location: Sovereign land in the Sacramento River, adjacent to 6645 Garden Highway, near Sacramento, Sacramento County.

Description: Authorize issuance of a General Lease – Recreational and Protective Structure Use beginning April 6, 2021, for a term of 10 years, for the use and maintenance of an existing single berth U-shaped floating boat dock, two steel pilings, gangway, utility conduit, and bank protection previously authorized by the Commission and an existing boat lift and 2-pile dolphin not previously authorized by the Commission.
