TIERED ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT PROPOSED:

- 1. Conditional Use Permit No. 20-08 (High Roller Dairy)** – The applicant proposes to establish an anaerobic lagoon digester, new open lot corrals, and free stall barns on an existing dairy located at 14782 8th Ave, Hanford, Assessor's Parcel Number 028-040-016.

The Kings County Planning Commission will hold a public hearing to consider the environmental document for the proposed project that is listed above. The public hearing will be tentatively held on Monday, December 6, 2021 at 7:00 P.M., in the Kings County Board of Supervisors Chambers, in the Administrative Building No. 1, Kings County Government Center, 1400 W.
