<u>Project Description</u>: The California Department of Toxic Substances Control (DTSC) proposes to implement the Remedial Action Plan (RAP) for the former Union Carbide Corporation (UCC) Torrance Distribution Facility. A RAP is a document that details the steps to be taken in the implementation of the selected remedial response actions at a Site in order to remediate environmental conditions. The RAP would be implemented under the terms of UCC's Voluntary Cleanup Agreement with DTSC and would include a combination of remedial activities including in-situ geochemical stabilization, soil vapor extraction, shallow soil excavation, and institutional controls in the form of restrictive land use covenants along with natural attenuation processes. The purpose of the proposed project is to address the identified contaminants of concern concentrations in the soil, soil vapor, and groundwater to levels to protect human health and the environment, consistent with the current and anticipated future commercial/industrial worker uses of the property.
