The proposed project would create fuel management zone (FMZ) 20 (7.9 acres) adjacent to the South Laguna residential neighborhood and South Coast Water District office and water reservoir and FMZ 21 (12.5 acres) surrounding a residential neighborhood and Mission Hospital Laguna Beach. Hand crews would reduce or clear vegetation load in 100-foot wide sections within the FMZs to reduce the risk of wildfire threat to residential and public structures. The majority of perennial root systems would remain, and native vegetation waste would be mulched and left on-site to minimize erosion. Non-native vegetation waste would be transported to a green waste recycling facility or landfill if not recyclable. Exclusion areas within both FMZs would be established to avoid disturbance of known cultural resources, big-leaved crownbeard, and Coulter's Matilija poppy.
