Project Title: Indian Oaks Maintenance Project, (Streambed Alteration Agreement # EPIMS-RIV-14912-R6).

Project Location: The Indian Oaks Maintenance Project (Project) is located along Tualota Creek at the Indian Oaks Campground, 38120 E Benton Road, in the City of Temecula, Riverside County, State of California; within Assessor’s Parcel Number 915-400-030; Latitude 32.57727 N, Longitude: -116.99672 W; on the U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) Sage 7.5 minute series quadrangle topographic map.

Project Description: The Project proposes to partially dewater the Indian Oaks Reservoir and remove accumulated sediment in the northeast and west side of the reservoir.

Project activities are limited to the dewatering and removal of accumulated sediment within the Project site. No additional water control structures are proposed.
