Project Title: El Dorado County Health Center (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ELD-17247-R2)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Weber Creek in unincorporated El Dorado County, State of California; Latitude 38.70653, Longitude -120.83339, Assessor's Parcel Number 327-213-034-000, 4212 Missouri Flat Road, Placerville, CA 95667.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ELD-17247-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, El Dorado Community Health Center, as represented by Terri Stratton.

The project is limited to mass grading of an unnamed tributary to Weber Creek in support of commercial development for the 12.42-acre parcel. During construction, the unnamed tributary to Weber Creek will be permanently filled or excavated by mass grading. Grading will be completed when the unnamed tributary is dry. Grading will result in approximately 23 square feet (<0.001 acres) of impacts to the unnamed tributary.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement for the project on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration / negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were / were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was / was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
