San Mateo County Parks proposes to conduct the Pilot Program at both Pillar Point Bluff and Quarry Park for 12 months (1) to determine if the above-mentioned rules are being adhered to and (2) to make management adjustments as needed to avoid or minimize potential impacts to the environment. To evaluate the impacts of the Pilot Program, an Adaptive Management Plan (AMP) has been prepared. Key components of the AMP are the impact indicators/metrics and measurable standards that Parks staff will monitor on a recurring basis throughout the Pilot Program. The AMP would allow Parks to manage the Pilot Program in a transparent and effective manner. The Mitigated Negative Declaration will be posted on the County Park website <https://parks.smcgov.org/> on July 15, 2021.
