Conditional Use Permit to construct and operate a 4.8-Megawatt photovoltaic solar power generating facility with battery storage capabilities on an approximately 35-acre property in the community of Daggett.

Potentially significant adverse impacts resulting from the proposed project include biological resources, cultural resources, hydrology and circulation. Said mitigation measures involve requirements for preconstruction surveys, implementation of avoidance and minimization design features, monitoring of earthwork activities and continued consultation with affected Native American tribal representatives, preparation and implementation of an approved Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) and preparation of a truck haul plan.
