

**A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE
OLYMPIC VALLEY PUBLIC SERVICE DISTRICT
AUTHORIZING THE GENERAL MANAGER TO EXECUTE
AND FILE THE NOTICE OF EXEMPTION FOR THE
HIDDEN LAKE LOOP WATER AND SEWER LINE REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Olympic Valley Public Service District (District) is a public agency organized pursuant to California Water Code §30000, et seq; and

WHEREAS, the District is replacing aged and undersized water and sewer lines serving nine (9) properties in the Forest Glen and Hidden Lake subdivisions; and

WHEREAS, the sewer project includes replacement of approximately 300-feet of existing 4-inch and 8-inch asbestos concrete sewer main outside existing easements with 6-inch PVC pipe in the center of easements; and

WHEREAS, the waterline project will install approximately 800-feet of 6-inch ductile iron pipe including replacing a portion of existing 2-inch galvanized steel pipe to improve water quality, meet standards for pipe diameter, and provide additional water supply and fire suppression reliability and redundancy; and

WHEREAS, the District is acting as Lead Agency for the Hidden Lake Water and Sewer Line Replacement Project (Project) under the California Public Resources Code §21000, et seq, (CEQA); and

WHEREAS, the District as Lead Agency has determined that the Project does not have a significant effect on the environment and is categorically exempt pursuant to § 15302(c) of Title 14, California Administrative Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Directors of the Olympic Valley Public Service District hereby directs the General Manager to execute and file the attached Notice of Exemption on the grounds that said project is categorically exempt from CEQA. The contents of said Notice of Exemption shall be filed with Governor's Office of Planning and Research State Clearinghouse and the Placer County Clerk's Office.
