**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Project includes minor selective demolition to walls, removal of loose or inaccurate materials, patching of adobe walls at existing cracks and damage, general wall prep to receive new whitewash and application of whitewash/lime wash on all wall surfaces of eight rooms in the Casa de Estudillo. Project protects structure and will improve the appearance of the property.



**REASONS WHY PROJECT IS EXEMPT:** No potential for significant impact to the environment is anticipated in compliance with CEQA §15300.2.
