Description of Nature, Purpose and Beneficiaries of Project:

Routine maintenance activities to clear stream channels, culverts, and the City's storm drain conveyance system of weeds, brush, trash and debris which would otherwise constrict the floodway channel in stormflow events. Routine maintenance at Greenhorn Dam includes removing emergent vegetation growing on the dam. Routine maintenance includes replacement or repair of infrastructure, such as leaking water lines. Proposed activities include brush and weed removal using mowers and weed eaters, hand removal of noxious weeds, removal and/or trimming of invasive blackberry, tree limbing, and occasional removal of dangerous trees (estimated 2-3 year) that threaten to fall and/or block storm drains/culverts. City will comply with Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement with Department of Fish and Wildlife.
