Subject: The Amador County Transportation and Public Works (County) proposes to replace the existing single-lane Bell Road Bridge (Bridge No. 26C-0026) over Big Indian Creek with a new two-lane bridge (proposed project). The proposed project is situated approximately 4 miles north of the City of Plymouth and east of Highway 49. The new replacement bridge is proposed to be a cast-in-place pre-stressed concrete slab with a span length of 52 feet – 6 inches and a width of 19 feet – 4 inches. The roadway at the bridge will conform to the existing roadway at approximately 400 feet from each side of the bridge.

Recommended Findings: The recommended finding is that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment.
