The Applicant proposes to operate a new public water system that will serve a new wine tasting room at the Blood Gulch Winery. The tasting room will be located within a new 3,600+/- sq. ft. structure. The tasting room will be open daily from 9:00 am to 5:00 pm. The site will host a maximum of twelve

Public Agency Approving Project: The Blood Gulch Water is carrying out the Project. The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board), Division of Drinking Water (DDW), is the Responsible Agency for the Project. The Division of Drinking Water has issued a permit for the above described Project on 12/28/2022, and has made the following California Environmental Quality Act Determinations regarding the project:

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to the effects within the State Water Board's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. The State Water Board has considered the Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
6. Findings were not made by the State Water Board pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
