NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION

The Planning Commission of the City of Bakersfield will hold a public hearing at 5:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on **THURSDAY, OCTOBER 21, 2021**, in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 1501 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield, CA, to consider the following:

Mitigated Negative Declaration for Conditional Use Permit No. 20-0379: LAV//Pinnacle Engineering is requesting adoption of a Mitigated Negative Declaration to facilitate construction of a truck stop on approximately 16 acres located generally at the south side of Taft Hwy and west of CA State Route 99. (Ward 7).
