Project Title: Public Safety Training Center Expansion

Project Location – Specific: Public Safety Training Center, 5743 Skylane Boulevard, Windsor, CA 95492

Project Location – County: Sonoma

Description of Project: The proposed project includes improvements at the existing Public Safety Training Center (PSTC) located at 5743 Skylane Boulevard in Windsor, California. The existing PSTC was built in 2000 to provide specialized training space for Law Enforcement, Corrections Officer, Emergency Medical Care, and Fire Technology Programs. The current PSTC is housed in 17 buildings and provides approximately 88,888 gross square feet (gsf) of instructional and support space. The proposed Project would include minor facility additions within existing school grounds, including an approximately 8,800 gsf building containing lab space, faculty office space, and support space.

Reasons why project is exempt: The project is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15301, 15311, and 15314 because the project involves minor facility additions within existing campus grounds that do not increase student capacity by more than 25% or add more than 10 classrooms. Environmental review did not identify any significant effects that would occur from the project, and the exceptions listed in Section 15300.2 of the CEQA Guidelines were found not to apply to the project.
