Project Title: Crow Canyon Roadway Shoulder Repairs Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-ALA-15171-R3)

Project Location (include county): located along Crow Canyon Road, at distances between 40 feet and 100 feet south of Crow Creek, between mile markers (MM) 5.83 to 6.25 in the County of Alameda, State of California; Latitude 37.76600°, Longitude -122.01707

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-ALA-15171-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Jim Browne/Alameda County Public Works Agency.

The Project is limited to the stabilization of the southerly embankment of Crow Creek, in order to maintain the existing Crow Canyon roadway. This will entail repair of the storm-damaged road shoulder at four locations and improving drainage by the replacement of old failed culverts at three additional locations along Crow Canyon Road.
