# <u>Description of Nature, Purpose, and Beneficiaries of Project:</u>

The project purpose is to reduce costly maintenance associated with road repairs, improve traffic flow, relieve congestion at the Interstate 5 (I-5) and South Main Street interchange, improve safety for the traveling public, and comply with current standards for guardrails. The project proposes reconstructing and widening a  $\pm 0.95$ -mile section of South Main Street between the I-5 overpass and the southern limits of the City of Red

Bluff. The proposed project would improve traffic flow by utilizing a two-way left turn lane, an upgraded traffic signal that services the hospital, a buffered bicycle lane, and the addition of a roundabout that involves impacts to 0.19 acre of wetlands.
