



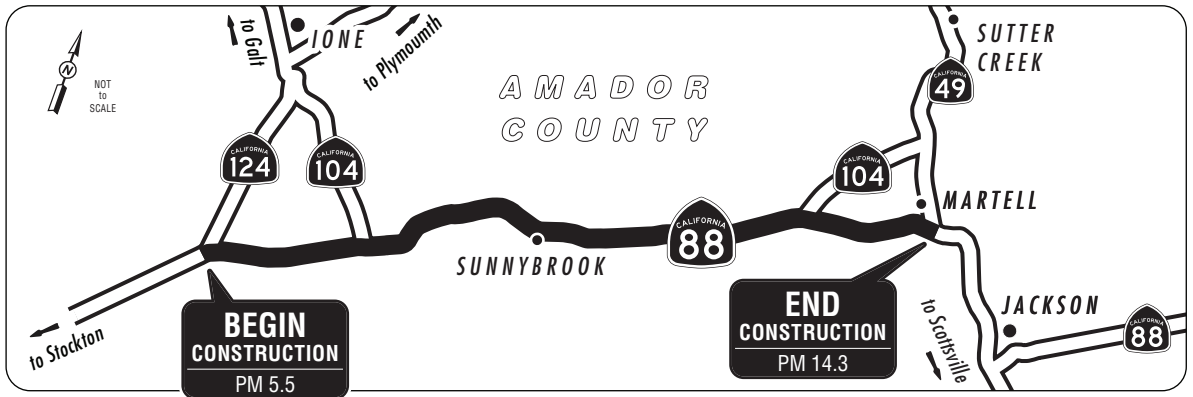

State Route 88 Roadway Improvement Project in Amador County?**



### WHAT IS BEING PLANNED?

The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) proposes to perform roadway improvements along State Route 88, between post mile 5.5 and post mile 14.3 in Amador County.

### WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE?

Caltrans has studied the effects this project may have on the environment. Our studies show it will not significantly affect the quality of the environment. The report that explains why is called an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration. This notice is to inform you that an Initial Study with Proposed Mitigated Negative Declaration has been prepared for the project and is now available for you to read and comment on. This notice also offers you the opportunity to request a virtual public hearing.
