**Project Title:** Amador SR 88 Roadway Improvements (10-0Q210) (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. AMA-37720-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located on State Route (SR) 88 at post mile (PM) 8.36 where it crosses Copper Creek, in the County of Amador, State of California; Latitude 38.339151, Longitude -120.893481; Section 29 and ¼ Section SW, Township 06N, Range 10E of the Mt. Diablo Meridian, U.S. Geological Survey (USGS) 7.5-minute quadrangle map lone.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number AMA-37720-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the California Department of Transportation, as represented by Udaya Shankar.

The project includes the relining of the existing 48" double culvert system at PM 8.36. The culvert work is part of a larger roadway improvement project along SR 88, between PM 5.5 and PM 14.3. The project is limited to the clearing and excavation of a 15-foot by 20-foot area at the outfall end of the culvert for a temporary pipe-liner installation pit, relining of the double culvert system with a Snap-Tite Culvert Lining System, water diversion installation, and riparian vegetation removal consisting of narrow-leaf willows below the top of the bank of Copper Creek.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above-described Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the  mitigated negative declaration /  negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures  were /  were not made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
