PROJECT DESCRIPTION: The State Water Resources Control Board (State Water Board) is a Responsible Agency for the Project. The State Water Board's Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF) Program is financing the Project referred to internally as Sunbird/Martinez Septic to Sewer Conversion Project. The Project includes construction and operation of 19,625 linear feet of sewer pipeline and a new lift station, as well as abandonment of existing onsite community septic systems. The project would connect the Sunbird Mobile Home Park and Torres-Martinez Community Center to Coachella Valley Water District's existing sanitation system tributary to Lift Station 55-21 (LS 55-21) and then to Coachella Valley Water District's Water Reclamation Plant No. 4 (WRP-4). The pipeline would be installed below grade within existing paved streets and rights-of-way. The pipeline alignment would primarily traverse public roads and a portion of the Torres-Martinez Desert Cahuilla Indian reservation land.

PUBLIC AGENCY APPROVING PROJECT AND CARRYING OUT PROJECT: The State Water Board has approved SRF financing for the Project described above on September 12, 2023. The Coachella Valley Water District will be carrying out the Project. The State Water Board has made the following California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) determinations regarding the Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. The Project will not have a significant effect on water quality impacts. This determination is limited to effects on water quality under the State Water Board's jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

2. A Mitigated Negative Declaration was prepared and adopted for the Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was adopted for the Project.
