Project Title: Kings Creek Pump Removal (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SCR-19645-R3)

Project Location: The Project is located at Kings Creek, a tributary to San Lorenzo River, at 19950 Kings Creek Road, Boulder Creek 95006, in the County of Santa Cruz, State of California; Latitude 37.20121, Longitude - 122.11918; Assessor's Parcel Number 087-041-22.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SCR-19645-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Vajrapani Institute.

The Project involves the removal of a 35.5 inch x 16.5 inch x 8 inch concrete block fixed to a large boulder in the creek bed and surrounding debris including old piping and plywood. Removal will include breaking the concrete with hand tools and disposal at a County landfill.
