



NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT A MITIGATED NEGATIVE DECLARATION Morse Recreation Center Project

Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) for the following project has been prepared by Cosumnes Community Services District (CCSD) pursuant to the guidelines and procedures for implementation of the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA). **PROJECT LOCATION:** The Morse Recreation Center ("proposed project") proposes to develop a new recreation center on 3 acres of undeveloped land within an approximately 14-acre parcel (Assessor's Parcel Number [APN] 132-0020-149-0000) that is part of the existing 30-acre Morse Community Park. The project site is located at the intersection of Bellaterra Drive and Fire Poppy Drive in the City of Elk Grove. **PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The proposed project includes development of a new recreation center designed to provide both indoor and outdoor recreation space to support the community including fitness programs, health and wellness events, instructional classes, sports leagues and tournaments. The project also includes new landscaping, lighting, and additional surface parking. **PUBLIC COMMENT:** The Initial Study/MND will be publicly available on Wednesday, March 30, 2022.
