The majority of the sewer force mains and gravity sewer will be constructed within public road right-of-way. However, that portion of the alignment starting at the north boundary of New Roberts Road until it reaches Sandalwood Drive is located within undeveloped private property that would require property dedications to YVWD to both construct and maintain the force mains. Construction of the pipeline alignment within the public road right-of-way would include trenches approximately five feet wide. A 20-foot-wide working zone would be required for spoil piles and equipment. Construction along the pipeline alignment outside of the public road right-of-way (south of Sandalwood Drive) would require an average width of 50 feet. It is anticipated that construction would take eight months and would occur in 2022.			
PROJECT IMPACTS: The Initial Study/MND was completed in accordance with the Lead Agency's Guidelines implementing the California Environmental Quality Act. The Initial Study/MND found that the environmental effects from the project would be less than significant with the incorporation of standard conditions and mitigation measures.
