NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING SPECIAL MEETING of the Bakersfield Planning Commission

The Planning Commission of the City of Bakersfield will hold a public hearing at 5:30 p.m., or as soon thereafter as the matter may be heard, on **WEDNESDAY, November 10, 2021**, in the Council Chambers of City Hall, 1501 Truxtun Avenue, Bakersfield, CA, to consider the following:

Consideration of Mitigated Negative Declaration for a License for the Bakersfield Multi-Use Trail along the Friant-Kern Canal: The City of Bakersfield is proposing to construct and maintain a 6-mile-long multi-use trail along the Friant-Kern Canal, from the Kern River Channel to 7th Standard Road. The trail would generally run in a north-south orientation. The trail would be used for alternative transportation and recreation as well as serve as interconnection to community parks, schools, centers, retail, and the Kern River Parkway. The trail would increase pedestrian and bicyclist safety, promote active modes of transportation, and reduce traffic congestion (Multiple Wards).

All written comments must be received by the Bakersfield Planning Department, 1715 Chester Avenue, Bakersfield; 661-326-3733 on or before the public hearing date/time indicated above. You may review and/or obtain copies of all public documents at the Planning Department. If you challenge the action taken on a specific project in court, you may be limited to addressing only those issues raised at the public hearing or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Bakersfield.
