Present Land Use/Zoning/General Plan Designation: The project site is currently undeveloped, consisting primarily of regularly disked dry-farmed wheat with native grassland areas. The project site is located within the Sand Creek Focus Area of the City's General Plan and is designated Hillside, Estate and Executive Residential/Open Space and Commercial/Open Space. The site is zoned Study District

Project Description: The proposed project would include a multi-generational single-family residential subdivision with 294 units, as well as recreational amenities and associated improvements. The proposed project would also include future development of an assisted living facility and neighborhood commercial development upon issuance of a Conditional Use Permit (CUP). Only 47.4 acres of the site would be developed, while the remaining 49.1 acres would be retained as open space. The project would require City approval of the following: General Plan Amendment, Master Development Plan/Rezone, Development Agreement, Vesting Tentative Subdivision Map (VTM), and Resource Management Plan.
