Project Title: 3364 Woodside Road (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SMO-19821-R3)

Project Location: The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Bear Creek, in the County of San Mateo, State of California; Latitude 37.48108, Longitude -122.26518; Assessors Parcel Number 072-151-330.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife has executed Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SMO-19821-R3, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to Glen Kauk.

The Project is limited to digging an 8.0-inch wide by 24.0-inch deep trench through a seasonal stream and installing a conduit service pipe that will be laid in and connected to the main service electrical panel. Work will be completed with hand tool such as shovels, and a pickaxe.
