Title: State Route 1 Class II Bike Lane Facility Improvements

Applicant: California Department of Transportation

Location: Sovereign land located on Assessor's Parcel Numbers 110-017-01 and 110-017-02, near Huntington Beach, Orange County.

Description: The Project proposes to reduce bicyclist fatalities and serious injuries on the California State Highway System by adding comprehensive Class II bike lanes in both directions along State Route 1 between Santa Ana River Bridge and Anderson Street. The State Lands Commission action is an approval of a 5-year General Lease – Public Agency Use through February 25, 2029.

This is to advise that the California State Lands Commission, as Lead Agency Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on February 26, 2024, and made the following determinations regarding the project.

- 1) The project will will not have a significant effect on the environment.
- 2) A Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) was prepared for this project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
- 3) Mitigation measures were were not made a condition of the approval of the project.
- 4) A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was or was not adopted for this project.
- 5) A Statement of Overriding Considerations was was not adopted for the project.
- 6) Findings were were not made pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.

The lead agency for the project, California Department of Transportation (Caltrans), adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration (MND) and Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program and approved the project on March 23, 2022. The California State Lands Commission has considered the MND as prepared for this project by Caltrans and adopted an independent Mitigation Monitoring Program incorporating Caltrans's document.
