**PROJECT TITLE:** Junction Ranger Station Roof Replacement **LOCATION:** Mount Diablo State Park **COUNTY:** Contra Costa

**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** Replace the roof on the historic Ranger Station in Mount Diablo State Park to protect this structure from weather damage, protect the integrity of the historic building. And allow for continued use. Work will:

- Remove all existing layers of roofing (currently asphalt shingle over deteriorating cedar shake);
- Repair and/or replace any rotted underlayment as needed;
- Reroof using CeDUR "Walden" synthetic roofing shingles that match the design, color, and detail of the
  original cedar shake roof; and
- Replace the existing rotted galvanized gutters with new, in-kind, gutters.
