**NOTICE OF EXEMPTION**

**Title:** Consider authorizing staff to take title to, remove, and dispose of two abandoned vessels in Sevenmile Slough, Sacramento County – W27250

**Location:** Sovereign land in Sevenmile Slough near Rio Vista, Sacramento County.

**Description:** Authorize the Executive Officer, or her designee, to take title to two abandoned commercial vessels, the tug *Valiant* and tug *Standard No. 2*, last owned by Michael Skarry, deceased, located in Sevenmile Slough, Sacramento County. After taking title, authorize the Executive Officer or her designee to engender the removal and disposal of the *Valiant* and *Standard No. 2* in any manner determined to be expedient or convenient and, in a manner, least disruptive to the surrounding environment.
