**DESCRIPTION OF THE NATURE AND PURPOSE OF PROJECT:** In order to continue efforts to improve accessibility within units of the State Park system, the California Department of Parks and Recreation proposes to construct accessible features within Point Mugu State Park including, but not limited to, parking striping, campsite facilities and accessible grating along an existing roadway. Along the Sycamore Canyon Trail improvements include improving the surface for entering the trail, installing trash receptacles on a new leveled surface, installing replacement bollards, accessible signage, accessible surface in front of an existing information shelter, and new signage at the end of the trail.
