Dear Ms. Lombardo:

A record search of the Native American Heritage Commission (NAHC) Sacred Lands File (SLF) was completed for the information submitted for the above referenced project. The results were positive. Please contact the Juaneno Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation - Belardes on the attached list for information. Please note that tribes do not always record their sacred sites in the SLF, nor are they required to do so. A SLF search is not a substitute for consultation with tribes that are traditionally and culturally affiliated with a project's geographic area. Other sources of cultural resources should also be contacted for information regarding known and recorded sites, such as the appropriate regional California Historical Research Information System (CHRIS) archaeological Information Center for the presence of recorded archaeological sites.

Attached is a list of Native American tribes who may also have knowledge of cultural resources in the project area. This list should provide a starting place in locating areas of potential adverse impact within the proposed project area. Please contact all of those listed; if they cannot supply information, they may recommend others with specific knowledge. By contacting all those listed, your organization will be better able to respond to claims of failure to consult with the appropriate tribe. If a response has not been received within two weeks of notification, the Commission requests that you follow-up with a telephone call or email to ensure that the project information has been received.

If you receive notification of change of addresses and phone numbers from tribes, please notify the NAHC. With your assistance, we can assure that our lists contain current information.

Project: Imperial & Euclid Residential Project, La Habra, CA

Dear Chairperson Belardes,

As part of the environmental assessment conducted pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) for the above referenced project, a record search by the NAHC of the Sacred Lands File (SLF) was completed on June 8, 2021. (Please see Attachment A.) The results of the search were positive. The NAHC indicated that the Juaneno Band of Mission Indians Acjachemen Nation may have additional information regarding these positive finds. A description of the project site and proposed project is provided below.

Please let us know if you have any information regarding tribal resources on or near the project site that you would like to share. Also please note that this request is in addition to the tribal resource consultation that the City of La Habra requested on May 26, 2021 as required pursuant to the Assembly Bill (AB) 52 CEQA requirements. The AB 52 tribal consultation requests were sent to the following three tribes that had previously contacted the City of La Habra requesting notification:

- Gabrieleno Band of Mission Indians - Kizh Nation
- Gabrieleno Tongva Indians of California Tribe Council
- Soboba Band of Luiseno

We request that you provide any comments or information to us by July 26, 2021 consistent with the extended AB52 tribal review period.




Figure 1. Project Site Location Map

Proposed Project: La Habra – Imperial & Euclid Residential Project (See Figure 1, Project Location Map and Figure 2, Project Aerial Map.)

Project Description: The project is an infill development that would construct 117 single family attached residential structures on a 1.4 acre property currently occupied by commercial buildings and parking lots. No underground facilities, other than project utilities, would be constructed as part of the project. (See Figure 3, Proposed Project Site Plan)


