**Present Land Use/Zoning/General Plan Designation:** The project site currently consists of undeveloped agricultural uses and is generally flat. The City of Winters General Plan designates the site as Open Space (OS), Low Density Residential (LR), and Neighborhood Commercial (NC). The site is zoned Open Space (O-S), Single Family Residential 7,000 Square-Foot Average Minimum (R-1), and Neighborhood Commercial (C-1).

**Project Description:** The proposed project would consist of various residential uses, including a subdivided 188-unit single-family residential community, a 57-unit townhome community, and an 84-unit multi-family residential complex; three commercial lots totaling 3.3 acres; 6.9 total acres of park uses; a new drainage channel parallel to the eastern site boundary; internal roadway improvements; associated utility improvements; new landscaping; and frontage improvements. The project would require City approval of a General Plan Amendment, Rezone, Tentative Subdivision Map, Planned Development, and an Affordable Housing Plan. The project could potentially also include a Development Agreement.
