Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Project site is located on APNs: 331-060-007, -008, -020, -023, and -030. The Project would include the construction of two concrete tilt-up buildings on 20.17 acres of land. Building 1 is proposed to be 105,537 square feet (sq. ft.) consisting of 6,000 sq. ft. of office space and 99,537 sq. ft. of warehouse space and is located on the north side of the site. Building 2 is on the southern end of the site and is proposed to be 292,715 sq. ft. consisting of 8,000 sq. ft. of office space, 7,000 sq. ft. of mezzanine, and 277,715 sq. ft. of warehouse area.

Major Plot Plan No. PLN23-0040 proposes to construct two concrete tilt-up buildings totaling 398,252 sq. ft. building area on the 20.17-acre Project site. The maximum building height allowed is 100 feet. The proposed building heights fall below this limit at 44 feet in height for Building 1 and 43.6 feet in height for Building 2. The Project includes a total of 354 automobile parking spaces, 41 truck trailer parking spaces, and 52 dock doors.

The Project's potentially significant impacts and mitigation measures are discussed in Section 4.1: Aesthetics through Section 4.15: Utilities and Service Systems of the Draft EIR.
